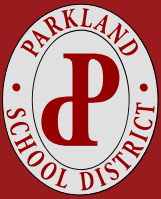

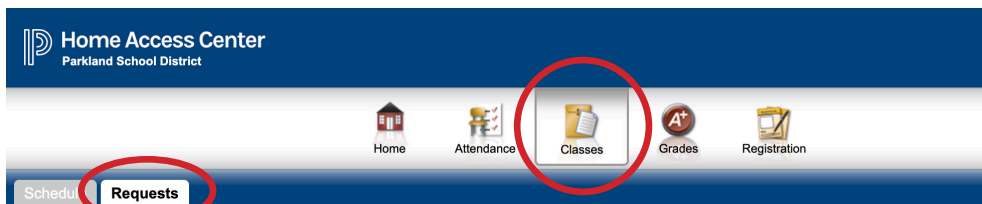

ONLINE COURSE REQUESTS: DIRECTIONS FOR STUDENTS

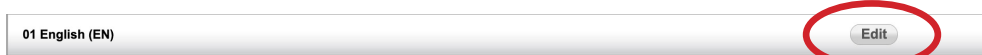

2 Click **Classes** then **Requests**

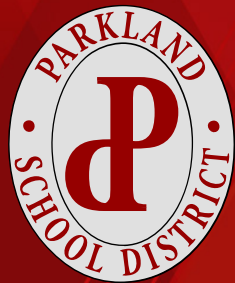
